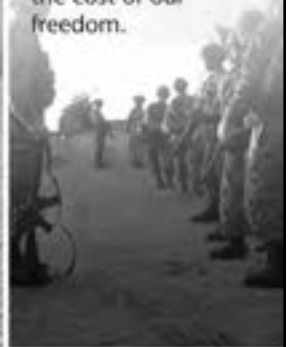

Message from The President



ARSENAULT, Azade 

WWI

Private Azade Arsenault, son of Joseph and Adèle Arsenault, served overseas in World War I. He was gassed in action and died shortly after the war.

ARSENAULT, Bélonie 

WWI

Private Bélonie Arsenault, son of Joseph O. Arsenault and Philomène LeBlanc, served from 1917-1918 in World War I. He was wounded during training which resulted in his spending the remaining years of the War in a hospital before being discharged in 1918.



ARSENAULT, Benjamin L. 

WWI

Private Benjamin L. Arsenault, son of Lamant and Balthide Arsenault, enlisted in the Army on March 2, 1916. He served in Canada, England and France with the 105th and 14th Battalions and received the First World War medals. Benjamin was discharged on August 10, 1918.

ARSENAULT, Benoit 

WWI

Private Benoit Arsenault, son of Adolphe Arsenault and Victine Gallant, served in World War I.



ARSENAULT, Benoit 

WWI

Private Benoit Arsenault, son of Arsène and Marie-Anne Arsenault, served overseas in World War I.

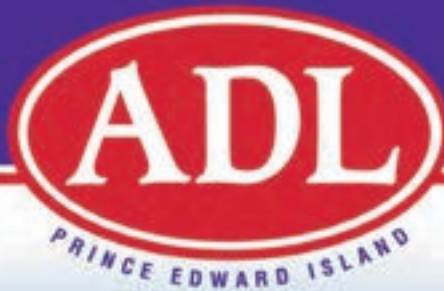

ARSENAULT, Benoît 

WWI


Private Benoît Arsenault, son of Léon (Sylvain) and Elizabeth Arsenault, served in France during World War I.

ARSENAULT, Calixte 

WWI

Private Calixte Arsenault, son of Joseph and Sophie Arsenault, enlisted in the Army in January, 1916. He served with the 105th Battalion in Canada and was discharged on medical grounds in Halifax on January 10, 1917. Calixte received the British War Medal.



ARSENAULT, Camille J. 

WWI & WWII

Private Camille J. Arsenault, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Fidèle Arsenault, enlisted in the Army in 1914. He served in the Artillery during WWI and saw action at the Battle of Vimy Ridge. He was discharged in 1918 but re-enlisted in the Second World War in 1941 and served with the Veterans Guard of Canada for four years. Camille was discharged in 1945.

ARSENAULT, Cyrus 

WWI

Private Cyrus Arsenault, son of Mr. and Mrs. Théophile Arsenault, served in the U.S. Army. He died in the U.S. as a result of gas inhalation received during the war on January 10, 1919. Cyrus was 23.



ARSENAULT, Cyrus 

WWI

Private Cyrus Arsenault, son of Laurent (Avis) and Madeleine Arsenault, served in England at the end of World War I.

ARSENAULT, Denis 

WWI

Private Denis Arsenault, son of Delphin and Marie Arsenault, enlisted with the Canadian Expeditionary Force in Charlottetown, PE in March 1916. After this training at Valcartier, Québec, he served overseas in England and France for the duration of the war. Denis was discharged in April 1919.

AYLWARD, Joseph Leonard 

KOREA

Joseph, son of Austin Aylward and Alma (Donahue) Aylward, was born on November 7, 1933. He joined the Army, serving in Korea with the Princess Patricia's Canadian Light Infantry as a paratrooper between 1952 and 1953. Joseph died on July 6, 2006.



BARNETT, Ralph Lester

WWII

Corporal Barnett was born in Alberton, PE. He enlisted in the Army on August 21, 1941 and served in Canada at #6 District Depot, O.A. Ralph was discharged on November 17, 1945.

BELL, James Murray 

WWII

James was born at Murray Harbour in 1922. During WWII, he joined the Navy and served on HMCS Joliette and HMCS Chelsea in the Atlantic, Irish Sea and English Channel. James was a member of the Royal Canadian Legion Charlottetown Branch #1 before he passed away in 2008.



BERNARD, Boyd 

WWII

Boyd was born in Tignish, PE on July 22, 1921. He served with a Toronto, Ontario unit, the Queens Own Rifles, from 1941 to 1944 in France, Italy and Holland. Boyd died on March 8, 2002.

BERNARD, Jérôme 

WWI & WWII

Jérôme Bernard, son of Joseph (Cpt.) Bernard and Marie LeClair, enlisted in the Army on November 29, 1915 and served with the Canadian Expeditionary Force in Canada, Britain and France. He was discharged in Québec on August 18, 1919. He re-enlisted during the Second World War on July 4, 1940 and served as a corporal in the Canadian Army (active) in Canada until his discharge in Halifax on June 9, 1945.

BERNARD, Johnny 

WWI & WWII

Regimental Sergeant Major Johnny Bernard, son of Joseph (Cpt.) Bernard and Marie LeClair, served in both WWI & II. In World War I, he served in Canada and overseas, where he was wounded at the Battle of Cambrai. In World War II, as R.S.M., he served in England in the 1940s as an instructor. He also served in Canada in 1942 as an instructor in small arms and detonations.



BERNARD, Philippe 

WWI

Private Philippe Bernard, son of Azade Bernard and Madeleine Arsenault, served in the First World War in England and in France at the end of the war. He was attached to the Graved detachment until 1918, with the 1st Depot Battalion of the Canadian Expeditionary Force.

BISHOP, Orrin 

WWI

Private Orrin Bishop, son of James Bishop and Mary McLure, served in WWI with the 105th Battalion in Valcartier, Québec, the United Kingdom and France. He was killed in action on July 9, 1917 and is buried in Bully Cemetery, northwest of Lars. Orrin was eighteen years old.



BLANCHARD, Isadore Felix

WWII

Private Blanchard, son on Angus Hyacinthe Blanchard and Priscilla Gallant, was born in Bloomfield, PE. He joined the Army on May 15, 1942 and served in Canada with the #6 District Depot. Isadore was discharged on July 6, 1942.

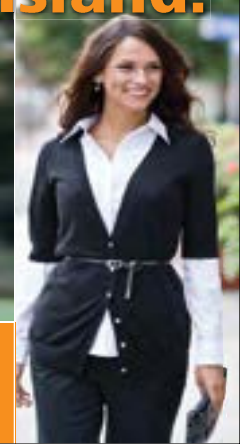

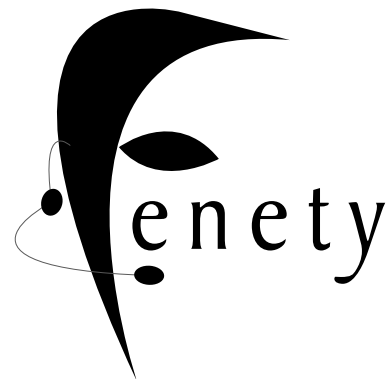

THOMPSON, Charles Cameron 

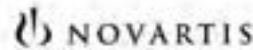

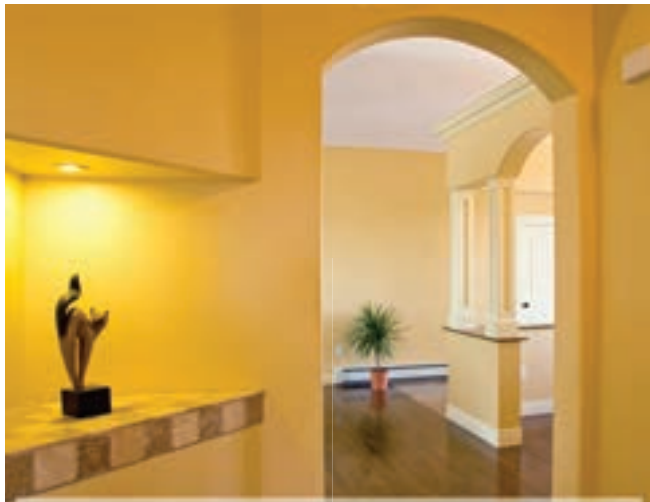

IN FLANDERS FIELDS

In Flanders Fields the poppies blow**
Between the crosses row on row,
That mark our place; and in the sky
The larks, still bravely singing, fly
Scarce heard amid the guns below.

We are the Dead. Short days ago
We lived, felt dawn, saw sunset glow,
Loved and were loved, and now we lie
In Flanders Fields.

Take up our quarrel with the foe:
To you from failing hands we throw
The torch; be yours to hold it high.
If ye break faith with us who die
We shall not sleep, though poppies grow
In Flanders Fields.



Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae

MD (1872-1918), Canadian Army

"In Flanders Fields," was written by Canadian physician and Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae while fighting in World War I shortly after presiding over the funeral of a friend killed in battle. The poem was published in 1915 and put to music in 1917, one year before Col. McCrae died. The poppies referred to in the song are of the flowers growing wild on top of the hastily made cemeteries for the soldiers in the Flanders region between France and Belgium.

**Many believe the original poem was written "In Flanders fields the poppies grow", but most people know this line as "In Flanders fields the poppies blow". On the Canadian ten dollar bill, the first few lines of the poem are written in small print. It was first printed as "poppies blow", but a few years after discovering the mistake, it was changed to "poppies grow". In recent years it has been argued that the validity of this mistake is unfounded and it has since been changed back to "as poppies blow". Despite the disagreements, few would argue that this poem is the most recognized and celebrated war memorial poem ever written.

MEDALS

Hell, who cares for those old men at the Legion bar,
That talk so silly of past wars fought afar?
They all sound like heroes as they display a scar
And who doff their medals – most look like a star!

Well, who cares for their medals and silly talk,
And what's so important on November 11th at eleven o'clock?
When they march in silence to that flag draped rock,
And bow their heads for two minutes, like sheep in a flock.

If you had seen them in battle, they were young then too,
Who went in large numbers and returned so few;
You'd know that the prayers for the dead of their crew,
Are not for "old men with medals" but for kids just like you!

Their medals, scars and "silly" talk
and even their prayers at that flag draped rock,
Are something no one ever mock
it's the price they paid for no shackles or lock!

So, maybe now, you'll give second thought
to the fact "they cared", that's why they fought –
but even if your cares they did not earn, for they were never sought –
their lives and scars are what they paid for the liberty we've got!
