

ADAMS, George David

WWII

George was born in Bloomfield District, son of Ernest and Sarah (Graham) Adams. He enlisted in the Army on June 13, 1945 and was discharged on February 14, 1946. He served as a Private in the Pictou Highlanders in Canada.

AFFLECK, James Arthur 

WWII

James was born in 1920 in Bedeque, Prince Edward Island. Prior to enlisting in the Army, James was a farmer. He served with the North Nova Scotia Highlanders in Canada, England, and France during World War II. James was killed in action by artillery shells on September 17, 1944, during the Battle of Boulogne. He is buried at Calais War Cemetery in France.



ARSENAULT, Frank Lewis 

WWII

Frank was born in Kinkora in 1913. He enlisted with the Royal Canadian Army Medical Corps during World War II, serving in Canada. In 1942, Frank travelled by car to Petawawa with two other soldiers. They did not return. The following day, the body of one of the soldiers was found in the Ottawa River. Later, the body of another soldier and F.L. Arsenault, as well as the car, were also found in the river. The cause of death was said to be an accidental drowning. Frank was married to Grace Rita (Gaudet) and they had four children.

ARSENAULT, John "Alban"

WWII

John was born in Bloomfield District, son of Benjamin "Ben" and Jeanne (Peters) Arsenault. He enlisted in the Army on March 1, 1943 and was discharged on March 25, 1946. He served as a Private in the Infantry in England and Italy.

ARSENAULT, Leroy Julien

WWII

Leroy was born in Bloomfield District, son of Colas "Nicholas" and Elizabeth (Gallant) Arsenault. He enlisted in the Army in 1943 and was discharged in 1945. He served as a Private in the Reconnaissance Unit in France and Belgium.



ARSENAULT, Patrick Raymond



WWI

Patrick was born in Bedeque, Prince Edward Island in 1896. He enlisted in the Army during World War I and was sent to France from England as a Private in December 1916. He was transferred in error due to a name mix-up, from the 14th Battalion to the 13th Machine Gun Company in January 1917, a unit attached to the 1st Canadian Division. Its role was to support the Infantry Brigades during the Battle of Vimy Ridge. Patrick was killed on the first day of the battle in 1917 and his body was never recovered. His name is inscribed on the Vimy Memorial in France.

BUXTON, Charles Benjamin Murray 

WWI

Charles was born in Cape Traverse, Prince Edward Island in 1893. He was a teacher and principal in Cape Traverse School and a School Inspector in West Prince before World War I. He enlisted in the Army with the Princess Patricia Canadian Light Infantry, serving in Belgium, England, and France. During the battle of Mount Sorrel in Sanctuary Wood, Belgium, just outside Ypres, he was declared missing on June 2, 1916 and then declared dead on June 4, 1916, as there was no evidence he was alive. His body was never found, and his name is engraved on the Menin Gate Memorial in Ypres.

CAHILL, Joseph Clifford

WWII

Joseph was born in Alberton District, son of Peter J. and Alice (Morrisey) Cahill. He enlisted in the Royal Canadian Army Service Corps on May 15, 1942 and was discharged on March 2, 1946. He served as a Gunner in Canada and Newfoundland.



CALLAGHAN, James Edward

WWII

James was born in Alberton District, son of Joseph and Lauretta (Kinch) Callaghan. He enlisted in the Royal Canadian Air Force on November 10, 1941 and was discharged on November 27, 1945. He served as a Corporal in Canada and the United Kingdom.

CAMPBELL, George Albert 

WWI

George was born in Wellington, Prince Edward Island in 1895. He was a farmer and a fisherman prior to enlisting in the Army. He served during World War I with the 6th Canadian Mounted Rifles, and the 5th Canadian Mounted Rifles during the Battle of Mount Sorrell in Belgium. His unit was in a supporting position in Maple Copse. On June 2, 1916, he was killed in action in the vicinity of Maple Copse not far from Ypres. He is likely buried in an unknown grave in Maple Copse Cemetery and his name is listed on the Menin Gate Memorial in Ypres.



CARR, Vincent Earl 

WWI

Vincent was born in 1894 in North Tryon, Prince Edward Island. Vincent served with the 55th Battalion, 36th Battalion, 86th Machine Gun Battalion serving in England, Belgium, and France. Vincent was killed in action in Passchendaele Ridge on the morning of October 30, 1917, during the Battle of Passchendaele in Belgium. He is buried in Cement House Cemetery in Langemark, Belgium. He was married to Bessie L. Carr.

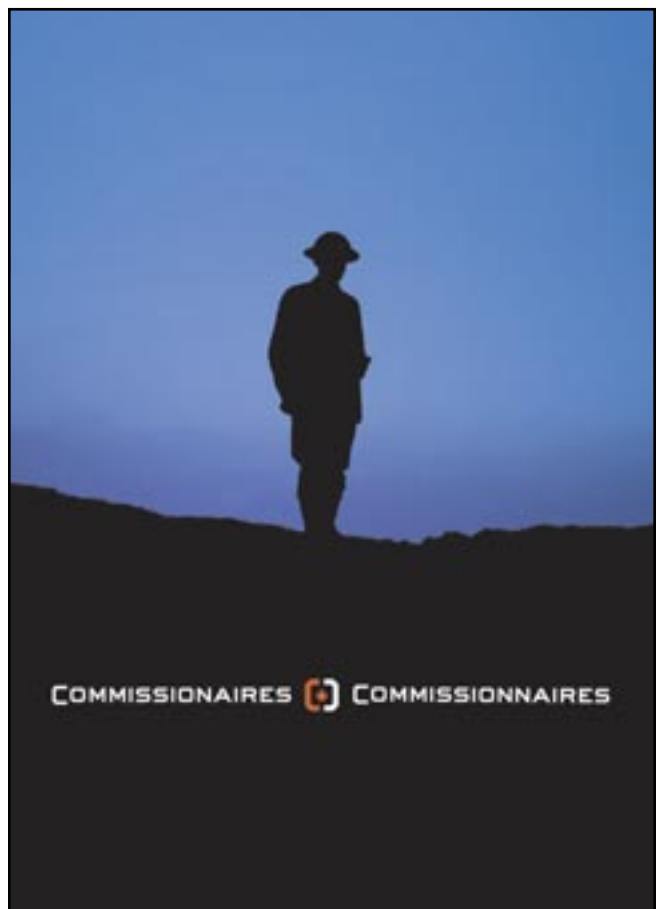

Edward was born in Bloomfield District, son of Jane Collicutt. He enlisted in the Army on January 8, 1943 and was discharged on March 16, 1943. He served as a Private in the #6 District Depot in Canada.



COOKE (McNEILL), Margaret 

WWII

Margaret was born in 1915 in Summerside, PEI. She served during World War II as a nurse on HMHS Letitia on which she cared for the wounded brought back from WWII battlefields of Europe to recover at home on Canadian soil. She made eleven crossings, each ten days one way, across the Atlantic returning home with the injured, war brides, and children of Canadian soldiers. Margaret served from 1943 to 1946. She was not the only member of the McNeill family to enlist, as six of her brothers signed up, four the same day, during the Second World War. It was all very hard on her mother, Pearl. Fortunately, all six McNeill boys returned home. After the war, Margaret continued her nursing career in Summerside, taking on the role of head nurse in the maternity ward of the old Prince County Hospital. She married Esmond "Dean" Cooke, the dean of pharmacy at the Dalhousie University, and the couple lived in Halifax and Sydney. They were married for thirty years before he passed away in 2005. She returned to Summerside to be with family. Margaret passed away on August 7, 2020, at the age of 105.

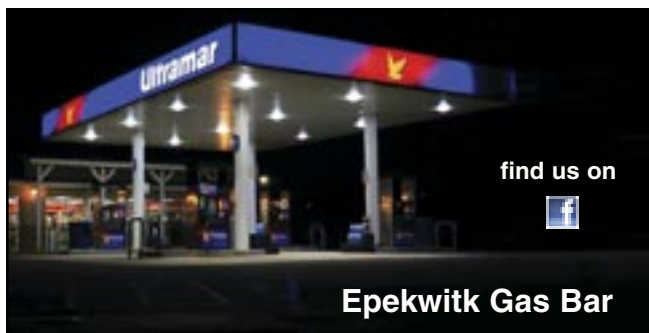

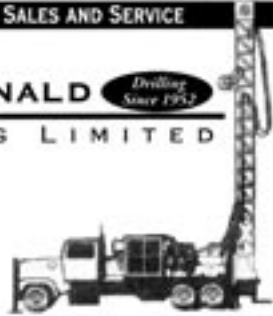

WWII

Norma was born in Alberton District, daughter of William C. and Margaret Blanche (Leard) Lawson. She enlisted in the Army on May 15, 1944 and was discharged on April 16, 1946. She served as a Sergeant in the Canadian Women's Army Corps in Canada and the UK.

LEA, Glen Allison



WWII

Glen was born in Prince Edward Island in 1917. He served with the Royal Canadian Air Force in Canada and England from 1941 to 1946. He received the War Medal 1939-1945 and Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and Clasp. After he was discharged from the Air Force, he became a produce dealer trucker and married Isabel. He was also a member of The Royal Canadian Legion Borden-Carleton Branch 10. Glen passed away in 2002.



LEFURGEY, Harold "Lloyd"



WWII

Lloyd was born in North Bedeque in 1926. He was a Marine Coppersmith's helper in Saint John before enlisting with the Canadian Infantry in 1945. While taking basic infantry training in Fredericton, he had an appendicitis attack and died while under anesthetic before the operation began. He was buried at Cape Traverse Free Church of Scotland Cemetery.



LEWIS, Alma Laura

WWII

Alma was born in Cascumpec, Prince Edward Island in 1925. She was the daughter of Harry Lewis Sr. and had three siblings: Florence, George, and John. She enlisted in the CWAC in 1943 during World War II and was discharged in 1945. Laura served in Kitchener, Ontario and Shilo, Manitoba as a Private. Laura participated in Bond Drives and was considered the Bond Queen. She received the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and War Medal 1939-1945.

LEWIS, Florence Eleanor



WWII

Florence was born in Cascumpec, Prince Edward Island in 1923 to Harry Lewis Senior and had three siblings: Alma, George, and John. She enlisted in the CWAC in 1943 during World War II and served in Canada. Florence trained in Halifax, Nova Scotia and then went to Belleview, Quebec to be trained as a cook. She contracted tuberculosis and was in Kempville, Nova Scotia then moved to Charlottetown. She received the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and War Medal 1939-1945. Florence passed away in 1946 and had a military funeral.



LEWIS, George



WWII

George was born in 1916 in Cascumpec, Prince Edward Island, son of Harry Lewis Sr. He had three siblings: Florence, Alma, and John. George enlisted in 1942 in Charlottetown, PE where he also did his basic training during World War II. He was posted to Halifax, Nova Scotia with the Royal Canadian Artillery. In November 1942, he was admitted to Camp Hill Hospital and was medically released from the Army in 1943. George received the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and the War Medal 1939-1945. George passed away in 1957.



LEWIS, John Robert 

WWII

John was born in Cascumpec, Prince Edward Island in 1921. He was the son of Harry and Janie (Butler) and three siblings: Alma, Florence, and George, who all served during World War II. He enlisted in the Canadian Army in 1941, at Charlottetown. After training in Charlottetown, he was sent to camp Petawawa, Ontario. There he was assigned to the 105th Anti Tank Battery which was based in St. Stephen, NB. He trained with them, then went with the 105th for further training to Aldershot, England. On D-Day, he landed with the 3rd Canadian Anti Tank Regiment onto Juno Beach in Normandy and went ashore into terrible enemy fire just fifteen minutes after the first wave of infantry went ashore. John survived and advanced for the liberation of France, Belgium, Holland, and Germany. John received several medals which include the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal, the War Medal 1939-1945, France and Germany Star, Defence of England Medal and French Government Medal of Appreciation. He received Honorable Discharge in February 1946. Upon his return to PEI where he farmed in Woodstock until he retired. John passed away in 2011.

MacDONALD, John Robert 

WWI

John was born on November 20, 1889 at Kensington, Prince Edward Island, the son of John and Annie (MacLaurin) MacDonald shortly after the death of his father. He left school at the age of sixteen to work on a farm. In June 1916, he enlisted with the Royal Navy as a signalman on HMAS Carol. After the Battle of Jutland, he received his Honorable Discharge at Leith, Scotland and immediately joined the Canadian Army in the infantry, serving in France, Belgium, and Germany. He was returned to Canada in April 1919. Approximately a year later he married Miss Hattie Laird Kelvin, PEI and bought the family farm. They had four sons and one daughter. For seven years following 1928, John was the High Sheriff in Prince County, PEI and in 1928 and joined the Customs Excise Preventive Service. When this organization was absorbed by the RCMP, he was made corporal and served successively in Alberton and Summerside in charge of Detachments. John then went onto Curran and Briggs, contractors for a new airport at Summerside as Personnel Manager. When this was finished, early 1942 he went to Pictou to be Security Supervisor at the Shipyard where he lived until his death on October 4, 1968.



MacFADYEN, Norman Campbell 

WWI & WWII

Norman was born in Kingston, Prince Edward Island on February 23, 1897 to John and Sarah MacFadyen. Norman first enlisted in World War I at the Kingston Hall in December 1915 when he was almost eighteen. He trained in Charlottetown with the 105th Infantry Battalion and in June 1916 he trained at Valcartier, Quebec. In July, he went to England for more training where he joined the 104th Battalion in January 1917. This Battalion would become the Fifty Canadian Division and would be transferred to France in March 1918 where it would become the 26th Battalion. He saw action in Amiens, Cambria, Arras and Canal De Nord. Out of a platoon of 38 men, only he and one other man would see the end of the war. In 1939, when World War II commenced, Norman again volunteered to serve as a member of the Veterans Guard of Canada and was stationed in Monteith, ON. Between Wars, Norman farmed in Meadow Bank and he also worked for 22 years as fruit and vegetable inspector. He later stated that following World War I: "The country was not equipped for the return of 600,000 soldiers, but the legion was formed and with recommendation to the Canadian Legislation brought better treatment for all World War II returnees." Norman passed away in 1992.



MacKAY, John H. 

WWII

John was born in Summerside, Prince Edward Island in 1923. He served with the Construction and Maintenance Unit in Newfoundland and Labrador, and across Canada during World War II. He was a member of The Royal Canadian Legion Borden-Carleton Branch 10. John married Roma (Howatt), and they lived in Albany and later in Crapaud. He received two service medals. John passed away in 2018.

MARTIN, Arthur Augustine "Gus"

WWII

Arthur was born in Bloomfield District, son of Hector and Angeline (Peters) Martin. He enlisted in the Army and Royal Canadian Air Force on September 1, 1939 and was discharged on November 1, 1968. He served as a Private in the Nova Scotia Highlanders Third Division in the UK and Continental Europe.



MARTIN, George "Vincent"

WWII

George was born in Bloomfield District, son of Hector and Angeline (Peters) Martin. He enlisted in the Army and Navy on June 12, 1940 and was discharged on November 23, 1945. He served as a Trooper in the HMCS in Canada.



MARTIN, Joseph Henry 

WWII

Joseph was born in Bloomfield District, son of Hector and Angeline (Peters) Martin. He enlisted in the Army on September 10, 1939 and was killed in action on August 9, 1940.

MARTIN, Joseph "Wilfred"

WWII

Joseph was born in Bloomfield District, son of Hector and Angeline (Peters) Martin. He enlisted in the Army on July 10, 1942 and was discharged on July 21, 1945. He served as a Private in France, the United Kingdom and Continental Europe.



MARTIN, Simon Edward

WWII

Simon was born in Bloomfield District, son of Hector and Angeline (Peters) Martin. He enlisted in the Army on May 15, 1942 and was discharged on August 22, 1946. He served as a Corporal in the #6 District Depot in the UK and Continental Europe.



MATTHEWS, Myrl Clifford

WWII

Myrl was born in Bloomfield District, son of Silas and Lydia (Wells) Matthews. He enlisted in the Army on February 11, 1943 and was discharged on December 13, 1945. He served as a Private in the Prince of Wales Own Regiment in PEI and Canada.

MATTHEWS, Wilfred Laurier

WWII

Wilfred was born in Bloomfield District, son of Archibald and Annie (Brennan) Matthews. He enlisted in the Army on June 20, 1940 and was discharged on July 10, 1945. He served as a Gunner in the Carleton and York Regiment in Canada.



McCORMACK, Michael

WWII

Michael was born in Bloomfield District, son of Harold and Elizabeth (Howard) McCormack. He enlisted in the Army on June 27, 1941 and was discharged on December 15, 1943. He served as a Gunner in the #6 District Depot in Canada.



McDONALD, Victor J. 

WWI

Victor was born in Cornwall, Prince Edward Island on October 20, 1895 to George and Isabel (Leonard) McDonald. Victor was a farmer prior to the enlisting on December 15, 1915 in Charlottetown, PEI with the 105th Overseas Battalion at the age of twenty. Victor served in the Army with the Canadian Infantry 26th Battalion New Brunswick Regiment, in England, France, and Belgium. Exposed to gas released by the enemy, he came home an invalid and spent the remainder of his life in the Veterans Hospital in Kentville, Nova Scotia. Shortly after the war ended, Victor succumbed to the disabling effects of gas and passed away on January 6, 1920 at the age of 24. His parents, as well as his siblings, George and Louis, survived him. Victor wrote letters to his brother Leo during his time overseas and in the hospital. Twelve of these letters have been preserved called The Victor McDonald Collection.

McKENNA, F. Everett 

WWII

Everett was born in Summerside, Prince Edward Island in 1936. He served for three years in the Army with the RHR II RCA in Canada. He was a member of The Royal Canadian Legion Borden-Carleton Branch 10. Everett passed away in 2002.



McNEILL, Everett Joseph 

WWII

Everett was born in the Alberton District, son of Linus/Tinus and Angelina (Gallant) McNeill. He enlisted in the Army on May 19, 1942 and was killed in action on August 2, 1944. He served as a Private in the Lincoln and Welland Regiment RCIC in Western Europe.



McNEILL, Glen

WWII

Glen was born in the Alberton District, son of Perley and Winnifred (A'Hearn) McNeill. He enlisted in the Army on March 17, 1943 and was discharged on July 29, 1943. He served as a Private in Canada.

MONAGHAN, William Henry

WWII

William was born in Bloomfield District, son of James and Catherine (Gaudet) Monaghan. He enlisted in the Army on September 15, 1941 and was discharged on January 25, 1943. He served as a Private in the Veterans Guard #19 Coy in Canada.



MOUNTAIN, Wilfred Yeo



WWII

Wilfred was born in Summerside, Prince Edward Island on December 3, 1922, the son of Leigh and Lena Mountain. He volunteered for active service in the Canadian Artillery on June 16, 1940, just six months after his eighteenth birthday. Following his enlistment and training, he would find himself in England, France and Holland. He received an honourable discharge from active service due to his illness. Wilfred passed away on September 26, 1945 and is resting in Summerside People's Cemetery.

PEGAHMAGABOW, Francis



WWI

Francis is one of the most highly decorated Indigenous people in Canada in World War I. He was part of the 23rd Regiment Northern Pioneers and was one of the first Indigenous people to join the fight over seas. He fought at a second battle of Ypres (first time Germans vs chlorine gas in WWI). One of the finest sniper aces of World War I, he was credited with 378 kills from behind the front lines. He ventured into no man's land to wait for the enemy. Francis captured around 300 prisoners and fought at the Battle of Mount Sorrel, Battle of the Somme, and Battle of Passchendaele. He suffered a gun shot wound to the leg in 1916 and returned to the battlefield. He received his first Military Medal in 1916 for his heroic actions, won a bar to his medal for his efforts in Passchendaele. In 1917, Francis developed pneumonia and because of gas attacks he suffered from chest pains for the rest of his life, passing away on August 5, 1962.

In 1939, he joined the Royal Canadian Navy and served in World War II on HMCS Iroquois in the Murmansk Run. Arthur received several medals during his time of service, 1939-1945 Star, France and Germany Star with Atlantic Clasp, Defence Medal, Canadian Volunteer Service Medal, and War Medal 1939-1945. After the war, he returned to Charlottetown to work at the local newspaper and was a member of The Royal Canadian Legion Charlottetown Branch 1. Arthur passed away in 1971.

WHYTE, Kelso Stewart 

WWII

Kelso was born in Lanark County, Ontario in 1926. He served in the Merchant Navy and in the Air Force with Summerside 419. Kelso served in Summerside, England, France, Winnipeg, Renfrew, and St. Bruno. He was the RCAF Association President in Charlottetown as well as a member of The Royal Canadian Legion Charlottetown Branch 1 for 22 years, President Corporal Branch France and the MWO on retirement. Kelso passed away in 1996.

YEO, George Elmer 

WWI

George was born in Kingston, Prince Edward Island on April 24, 1893. As a young man he went to Vernon, British Columbia to work on a farm prior to the start of World War I. Following the start of World War I, George volunteered for service in the Canadian Army where he would join the 47th Battalion of the Canadian Machine Gun Corp. Following training in Canada, he was shipped overseas to England and again more training then onward to France for combat. In 1917, George and the troops camped among the sand dunes of Etaples. Immense concentrations of Commonwealth reinforcement camps and hospitals were in this area. The battlefields were to the north and south of Etaples. George died in action on November 20, 1917 at the age of 24. George is buried in the Etaples Military Cemetery in Pas de Calais, France. He is also commemorated on page 354 of the First World War Book of Remembrance located in the Peace Tower in Ottawa.



YEO, Horace Willard 

WWI

Horace was born in Northam, Prince Edward Island on January 12, 1897 to John E. and Mary Jane McKay Yeo. When Horace turned eighteen, he volunteered for the Canadian Infantry on May 1, 1915. Following his military training, he was then transferred to the 60th Battalion Canadian Infantry with the Quebec Regiment. He travelled to France by way of England. He found himself on the battlefield in Pas-de-Calais where on September 20, he would be fatally wounded, at the young age of nineteen. His grave is in Vimy.
