
Dominion Command along with the Veterans Organization Emergency Fund has assisted many hurting branches to continue through this financially tough time.

PEI has a strong reputation for friendly, well-connected communities of folks who work together to make local life as positive as possible. Stewart Ives Dewar was one who helped grow the province's long-standing reputation.

Mr. Dewar, of Lower Montague, passed away on Sunday, March 21 at age 94.

"We sure will miss him," Montague Legion past-president Debi Smith said.

Ms. Smith believes her comrade's experience of the world through the Second World War instilled a sense of duty to serve his community and to pass along values such as the importance of working hard to achieve peace and freedom.

Mr. Dewar was underage when he enlisted near the end of the war and fortunately wasn't dispatched to fight overseas before it ended.

He did however, dedicate decades of spare time to community service, mostly through the Montague Legion Branch #8.

"We could hardly get him to slow down, even as he got older," Ms. Smith said.

Mr. Dewar volunteered for everything from peeling potatoes and carrots for fundraising dinners, to meeting and greeting with students during Remembrance Day ceremonies, to chairing the poppy campaign right up until last year.

"He had an encyclopedia for a memory," Ms. Smith said.

To her and many others Mr. Dewar was the go-to storyteller at the Legion.

"If a question came up about any of the past members he'd be the one to tell you who was who, what they did when and who they were connected to," she added.

Mr. Dewar earned numerous awards including Life Member of the Legion, Meritorious Service Medal (the next service award level up) and the Canadian Legion's highest service award, the Palm Leaf Award. He also added two Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Medals to his collection.

"He loved touring around to talk to the students," Ms. Smith said, referring to prize presentations to winners in the Legion's annual Remembrance Day Essay/Poetry contests. Mr. Dewar would read and help judge all of the entries from local schools. He signed hundreds of certificates hoping to encourage students to think about the meaning of Remembrance Day.

He was also an active participant of in-school Remembrance Day ceremonies held in the lead-up to November 11.

Mr. Dewar had a knack for building and connecting communities. He enjoyed chatting with everyone about everything.

He was known to regularly visit the Legion office just to chat. On the same day he would be expected to casually stop in to any number of his family members' homes for a chat or to stick around for a meal. When not sharing meals with family he had several favourite breakfast and lunch locations in the Montague area (the Lady Slipper or Stella's) where, once again, he would strike up a conversation with other patrons just to keep abreast of how everyone was doing.

"He was a great listener," Legion member Maxine Evans said. Her friendship goes back to when she worked with Mr. Dewar when he was meat manager in a local business. He retired at age 65.

"We ended up being a bit of a family at work and a lot of that was because of Stewart," she said.

Mike Brothers, one of Mr. Dewar's grandchildren, remembers always looking forward to going to the store to see his grandfather, knowing he would be treated with a slice of salami along with a welcome greeting.

"It seems a lot of people around here have that memory of looking forward to going in to chat with him," Mr. Brothers said.

Family was everything to Stewart, Ms. Smith said.

Mr. Dewar enjoyed watching his family grow to 16 grandchildren and 33 great grandchildren. He really liked going to church every Sunday, Mr. Brothers said. The kids would often sit by him and his chest would puff right up.

Mr. Brothers is happy to say his granddad enjoyed great health and state of mind well into his 94th year.

Mr. Dewar's beloved wife Peggy passed away about 40 years ago. Mr. Dewar is survived by his children, Douglas Dewar (Irene), Debbie (Grant) Dixon, Nancy Brothers, Brenda (Charlie) Fay and Stephen (Barb) Dewar. He had 16 grandchildren, 33 great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews. His funeral service was held in the Hillcrest United Church.

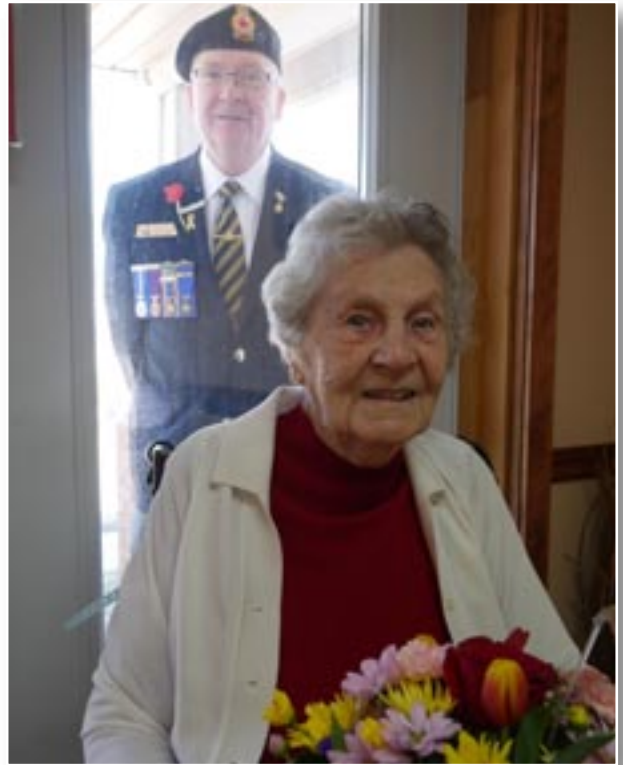

100 Years of Radio on PEI

March 2021 marked the centennial of radio broadcasting in PEI. A ground-breaking event led to the development of what we now take for granted - broadcast media.

Enthusiastic amateur radio operators called “hams” had been using Morse code for years. It was a demonstration of how a wireless radio set could receive concert music that provided proof that the latest technology had arrived on the Island.

It happened on March 11, 1921 in the Provincial Technical School in the Rena MacLean Memorial Hospital on the grounds of Government House in Charlottetown. Keith S. Rogers and his class of adult students successfully tuned into a broadcast from similar students at Union College in Schenectady, New York. A week later, the event was repeated for local dignitaries with special greetings for the PEI audience from New York.

World War I saw Keith Rogers posted with the Canadian Army in 1914 as a fortress signals officer at Citadel Hill in Halifax. In Charlottetown, Government House was turned over to the war effort, specifically as a convalescent hospital for recovering veterans. The construction of the Rena MacLean Memorial Hospital next door provided additional beds and eventually, as the focus



turned from convalescent to rehabilitation for veterans, it housed the Provincial Technical School.

The 1921 broadcast showed the direction ahead, and Rogers began broadcasting locally that fall as an amateur with both announcements and music from phonographs.

The Charlottetown Radio Association was formed to gain a club license in 1923 for members of the group. Using that license, Walter Burke started broadcasting church services from Trinity Church in Charlottetown on January 25, 1925—only the second church in Canada to do so.

In 1925, Rogers obtained the first commercial radio license in Eastern Canada for a station that eventually became CFCY. Later, he planned for TV broadcasting on PEI, which his family completed after his death, launching CFCY-TV on July 1, 1956. His dream of connecting people through the airwaves of “the Friendly Voice of the Maritimes” was realized and the stations continue today with Maritime Broadcasting as the current owners of CFCY/Q93 and CBC purchasing the television operations.

A private event at Government House on March 11 recognized the role that Fanningbank played in the early days of radio on PEI.

100 Years of the Remembrance Day Poppy



The symbol of Remembrance Day is the red poppy, which grows on the First World War battlefields of Flanders (in Belgium) and northern France. The poppy as a symbol of death and renewal predates the First World War and dates back as far as the Napoleonic wars in the 19th century. The seeds of the flower may remain dormant in the earth for years, but they will blossom in abundance when the soil is disturbed. As the artillery barrages began to churn the earth in late 1914, the fields of Flanders and northern France saw scores of red poppies appear.

The first person to use the poppy as a symbol of remembrance was Moina Michael, a member of the American Overseas YMCA, who had been inspired by Lieutenant-Colonel John McCrae's poem "In Flanders Fields." Michael pledged "always to wear a red poppy of Flanders Fields as a sign of remembrance and the emblem of "keeping the faith with all who died,"" referencing a line in the poem.

On 9 November 1918, Michael shared her pledge with her colleagues, who asked to wear poppies along with her. The next day, she purchased 25 silk poppies with money given to her by YMCA employees for her work on a YMCA conference in New York City. She pinned one to her coat collar and gave the rest to her colleagues. Over the years, she worked to popularize the poppy as a symbol of remembrance. The National American Legion adopted the symbol at its conference in April 1920 after hearing Michael's campaigning.

Anne Guérin of France was inspired by the same campaign. She too had been touched by McCrae's poem, and became a vigorous advocate of the red poppy. Guérin started the American and French Children's League, which sold cloth poppies to raise money for people suffering in war-torn France, particularly orphaned children. In 1921, she travelled to Britain and Canada and persuaded both the British Legion and the Canadian Great War Veterans Association (a predecessor of the Royal Canadian Legion) to adopt the poppy as their symbol of remembrance as well.

The veterans' association chose Jewish-Canadian philanthropist Lillian Freiman to lead the poppy campaign in Canada. Among its patrons were Governor General Byng and his wife, Lady Byng. The first "poppy day" in Canada (and Britain) occurred on 11 November 1921. Millions of poppies were brought to Canada from Guérin's organization in France. They were supplemented by cloth poppies created by Canadian women, some of whom made the flowers in Freiman's home in Ottawa. Members of the Imperial Order Daughters of the Empire (IODE) in Winnipeg also made poppies. By 1922, lapel-worn poppies were manufactured and distributed by veterans in Canada. The Royal Canadian Legion, formed in 1925, has run the poppy fundraising campaign in Canada ever since.

Today, millions of Canadians wear the bright red emblem as a symbol of remembrance, leading up to and on 11 November. The Poppy campaign raises funds to support veterans and their families.

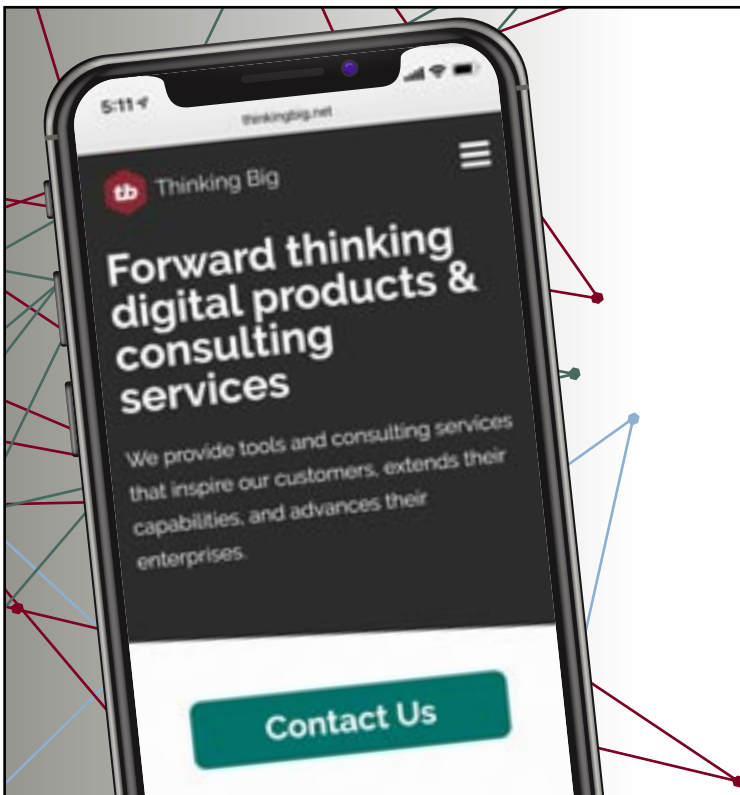

The Battle of Groningen

Lest we forget



*Thank you for your service,
your sacrifice, and our freedom.*

Groningen is the largest Dutch city in the northern part of The Netherlands. This city was liberated by the 2nd Canadian Infantry Division after a heated battle.

On April 13, 1945 troops from the 4th Royal Hamilton Light Infantry entered the city from the southwest, meeting strenuous resistance from German S.S. troops. Fighting off snipers, and in many cases clearing buildings room by room, the 6th Canadian Brigade (including the 11th-12th Les Fusiliers Mont Royal, the South Saskatchewan Regiment, the Royal Regiment of Canada and the Queen's Own Cameron Highlanders of Canada) entered the city from the south. On April 14, the 5th Canadian Brigade (the Black Watch of Canada, le Regiment de Maisonneuve and the Calgary Highlanders) entered the city from the west. The German Commander and his staff surrendered on April 16; the four-day battle cost the 2nd Division 209 casualties and accounted for 2,400 enemy prisoners.

ALCHORN, Vinton Edward 

WWI

Private Alchorn was born in Fairview on April 7, 1888. His Parents were James Fenton and Elizabeth Jane (Moorside) Alchorn. His siblings were Fenton, Urban Dean, Elinor (Nellie), Melville, Lena and Roland. Before enlisting, Vinton lived in Borden and worked as an Oiler. Private Alchorn signed up in Charlottetown on April 3, 1918. He was 29 years old and single. He served with "H" COY 1st Depot BN. N.S. Regiment which was tasked to provide reinforcements for the Royal Canadian Regiment, 25th, 85th and 185th Battalions through the 17th Canadian Reserve Battalion overseas. His Military Attestation Records state he was 5' 6 1/2" tall with grey eyes and dark brown hair. Following the war, Vinton settled in Maine, USA. He married but never had children.

AULD, James "Walter" 

WWII

Walter was born on October 21, 1923, in Glenwood, PEI. He was the son of James and Margaret Auld of O'Leary Station and a garage mechanic with Corney Bros in Summerside. After enlisting in the Army in 1942, he initially trained as a rifleman, but as his mechanical knowledge was assessed as 'superior', he was transferred first to Princess Louise Fusiliers (Motor Division) and later the Algonquin Regiment. He served during World War II in Canada, the United Kingdom, France and The Netherlands. On November 1, 1944, during operation Suitcase, he lost his life near Welberg, The Netherlands. He is buried in the Canadian War Cemetery in Bergen op Zoom, The Netherlands.



AVERY, Leonard Stephen 

WWII

Leonard was born in Badeque, PEI, on March 20, 1924, the son of John Avery and Mary Arsenault. He enlisted in the Army in 1943 with the First Garrison Battalion to serve during World War II. He was on guard duty at the Chippawa Power Canal in Welland County, Ontario. On August 23, 1943, he was accidentally killed while examining a rifle.

BUOTE, Joseph Ernest 

WWII

Joseph was born in Mayfield, PEI in 1918. He enlisted to serve during World War II as a volunteer in the Canadian Army on April 15, 1943. His basic training as an infantryman was conducted in Charlottetown, PEI and in Aldershot, NS with the North Nova Scotia Highlanders. Initially, in 1943, he served in Mulgrave, NS with the regiment guarding the Strait of Canso. His unit was transferred to England later that year where it trained and readied for the Battle of Normandy. In June 1944, his regiment landed at Juno Beach as part of the Ninth Canadian Infantry Brigade. Following days of combat with his platoon, he received a head wound during a night mortar attack outside of Caen and was evacuated to England. Following weeks of recuperation, he was transferred to the Canadian Forestry Corps and served in Scotland as a professional woodsman in military camps near Loch Ness. At wars end, and with demobilization, he was repatriated to Canada to join his wife Clarice and three children on Prince Edward Island and was honourably released on July 24, 1945. He was a member of The Royal Canadian Legion North Rustico Branch 13 for 45 years. Joseph passed away in 2004.

BURDETTE, Alton Josiah

WWII

Alton Josiah Burdette was born in Fairview to parents Thomas and Harriet (Gorveatt). His siblings: Freda, Eleanor, Norma, Gloria, Edison. Following the outbreak of World War II, Alton joined the Canadian Army until 1942. He then became a member of the First Special Service Force, known as "The Devil's Brigade" from 1942 to 1944. The Devil's Brigade was a joint World War II American-Canadian commando unit. The unit was invaluable to operations in Italy. Alton married Sadie Munn and they settled in Toronto, Ontario. Alton had two children: John and Jean.



CANNON, William "Willie" 

WWII

Willie was born in Pownal, PEI, in 1921, the son of Cecelia and Daniel Cannon and grew up in Mount Mellick. He enlisted in the Army and was a rifleman with the Regina Rifle Regiment serving in Europe during World War II. Willie was killed in action on February 16, 1945, in The Netherlands, at the age of 24. He is buried at the Canadian War Cemetery in Groesbeek, The Netherlands.

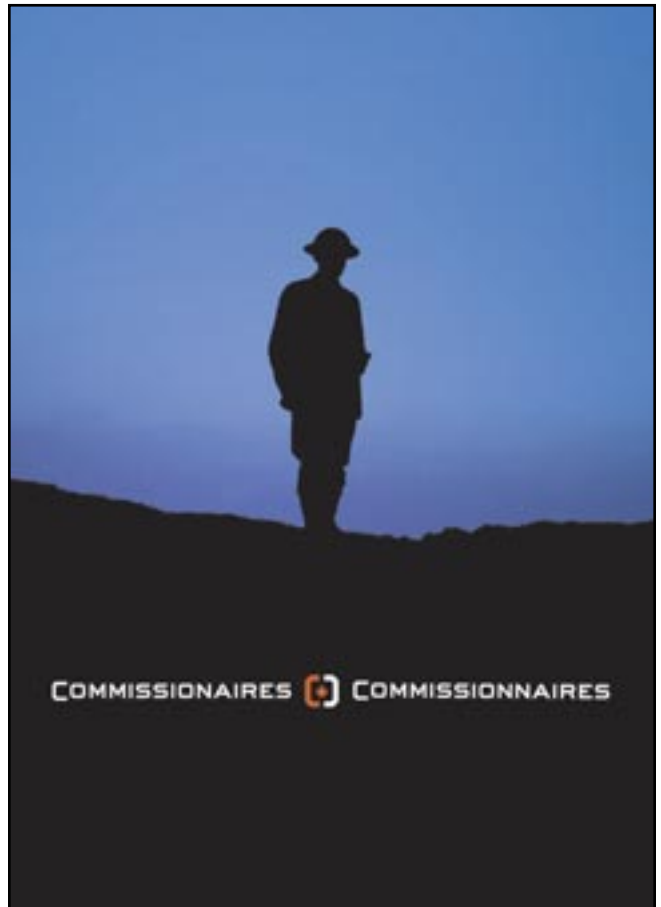

He is buried in the Canadian War Cemetery in Holten, The Netherlands.



DRAKE, Arthur Vernon 

WWII

Vernon, son of Lemuel and Carrie Drake, was born in Meadow Bank, PEI in 1921. He enlisted in the Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve in Charlottetown in 1940. He served aboard HMCS Prince David from 1940 to 1943; HMS Glasgow from 1943 to 1944; HMS Sheffield in 1944; HMCS Uganda from 1944 to 1945. He was discharged in 1945. Vernon passed away in 2002.

He finished his career as Standards WO at the Canadian Forces School of Military Engineering at Gagetown, NB.

Private William J. Gaudet was born in Tignish, PEI in 1925. In 1943, and at only eighteen years of age, he left PEI to join the war effort. He enlisted in the Army with North Shore (NB) Regiment and served from 1943 to 1946. After initial infantry training in New Brunswick and in Nova Scotia, he deployed to Europe. He served in Germany, Belgium, Holland and England during World War II. After the war, he married Noreen Doucette and together they moved to Boston, Massachusetts where he worked as a construction inspector on the Callaghan Tunnel Project. He later returned to Tignish and continued to work as a construction inspector mainly on island wharf projects. Along with this Bill took over his family farm with his wife, five sons and three daughters. He was a long-standing member and past president of The Royal Canadian Legion Tignish Branch 6. Bill passed away on November 1, 2008.

After enlistment in 1916 with 105th Battalion C Company, Private Hooper transferred to the 14th Battalion of the Canadian Infantry and was sent to France. On March 30, 1917, he died at No. 30 Casualty Station of gunshot wounds to his leg and left arm. He is buried at Aubigny Communal Cemetery Extension in Aubigny-en-Artois, France.

HOWATT, John Goodwill 

WWI

John was born in 1894 in Cape Traverse, PEI. A farmer prior to World War I, Private Howatt arrived in England in June 1916, where he was transferred to the 25th Battalion of the Canadian Infantry and sent to France in November 1916. On August 9, 1918, during the second day of the Battle of Amiens, he was severely wounded in his back and shoulder from gunshot, leaving him paralyzed from the waist down. He was transported to England and operated on but died in a London hospital on September 7, 1918. He is buried in Brookwood Military Cemetery in Surrey, England.



HUGHES, James Emmet 

WWII

James was born on April 7, 1911, in Kinkora, PEI. He joined the Waterman Steamship Agency and was a trimmer aboard the SS Ramapo, travelling between North America and England with badly needed supplies. On February 16, 1942, the ship was torpedoed by a German u-boat on the Caribbean Sea a few days after leaving Bermuda en route to North America. All hands were lost, including James.

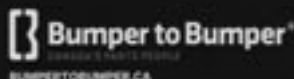

Alma was born in Cascumpec, PEI in 1925, the daughter of Harry and Janie (Butler) Lewis. She enlisted during World War II in the Canadian Women's Army Corps (CWAC) in 1943 and was discharged in 1945, serving in Canada. Alma was stationed in Kitchener, Ontario and Shilo, Manitoba as a Private. Alma participated in Bond Drives, and was elected Bond Queen by her unit. She received the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and War Medal 1939-1945. Alma retired to Belleville, Ontario and in later years moved to Kitchener, Ontario.

LEWIS, Erskine William 

WWII

Erskine was born in Alberton District, the son of Wansley and Gertrude (Skerry) Lewis. He enlisted in the Royal Canadian Naval Reserve on July 7, 1941 and was killed in action on February 6, 1943. He served as an Able Seaman on the Ship Louisburg.

Florence passed away in 1946 and had a military funeral.

George was born in 1916 in Cascumpec, PEI, the son of Harry and Janie (Butler) Lewis. George enlisted in 1942 in Charlottetown, PEI where he also did his basic training during World War II. He was posted to Halifax, Nova Scotia with the Royal Canadian Artillery. In November 1942, he was admitted to Camp Hill Hospital in Nova Scotia. He was medically released from the Army in 1943. George received the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and the War Medal 1939-1945. George passed away in 1957.

LEWIS, John 

WWII

John was born in Cascumpec, PEI in 1921, into the large family of Harry and Janie (Butler) Lewis. Four of their family served in the Canadian Army during World War II. The other three were Alma, Florence, and George. He enlisted in the Canadian Army in 1941, in Charlottetown. After basic training, he was sent to Camp Petawawa in Ontario where he achieved the rank of Gunner. He was assigned to the 105th Anti Tank Battery which was based in St. Stephen, New Brunswick. John next went with the 105th to Aldershot, England and trained with them there. On D-Day, he landed on Juno Beach in Normandy with the 3rd Canadian Anti Tank Regiment just fifteen minutes after the first wave of infantry went ashore. Despite terrible enemy fire, they prevailed and he went on with them to participate in the liberation of France, Belgium, Holland and Germany. **MacDONALD, Daniel Joseph** **WWII**

Daniel was born on his family's farm in Bothwell District. He enlisted in the Army in August 1940 and was discharged in 1945. He served as a sergeant in Italy. While serving in 1944, he was wounded twice and as a result, MacDonald's left arm and leg were amputated. After returning home in 1945, he wanted to continue to serve his community and joined the War Amps PEI Branch. MacDonald's political career began in 1962, and ten years later he ran his first federal campaign. He was elected to represent the riding of Cardigan and was named the Minister of Veterans Affairs. MacDonald also worked to change veterans' pensions to make them more generous and introduced other pensions such as disability and prisoner of war pensions. In the 1970s, Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau and MacDonald devised a plan to move the headquarters of the Department of Veterans Affairs from Ottawa to Charlottetown. MacDonald died on September 30, 1980 and received a state funeral in Charlottetown. Today, the main facility (national headquarters of Veterans Affairs Canada) is located in Charlottetown and is called the Daniel J. MacDonald Building.

His parents were Archibald B. and Isabel (MacKenzie) McDonald and his siblings: Angus, Flora Isabel, Louise Christina, Mary Eliza Flora Isabel II, Donald, John, and Margaret Sophia. He was working as a farmer in Rice Point when he enlisted. He already had been active with the 82nd Regiment Militia and volunteered with the 105th Overseas Battalion in Charlottetown on October 11, 1915. He was twenty years old and single. Following World War I, Norman married Florence Catherine MacQuarrie in 1935. They settled in Nine Mile Creek and had five children: Norma Isabel, Norman, Parker, Amelia Christine, and Mary Jean. With the start of World War II, Norman returned to service as a member of the Veterans Guard. He was responsible for recruit training in Halifax, Nova Scotia. This continued until the end of the war when he then returned to Nine Mile Creek. He passed away in 1982 in Rice Point.

**MacLEAN, John Angus** **WWI**

Angus was born in Lewes District. He completed degrees in science at both Mount Allison University and the University of British Columbia. He left farming to enlist in the Royal Canadian Air Force in 1939 and was discharged in 1947. He achieved the rank of Wing Commander and served in Europe. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross. After MacLean returned to PEI, he was elected to Parliament in a 1951 by-election and held his seat until he left federal politics in 1976. MacLean served in the cabinet of Prime Minister John Diefenbaker as Minister of Fisheries. In November 1976, MacLean was elected to the provincial legislature and led the party to victory in 1979. MacLean retired as premier in 1981 and returned to the family farm. In 1991 he was made an Officer of the Order of Canada. He died on February 15, 2000. Today, there is a provincial government building named after him which is located in Charlottetown and there is also an award named after him (Hon. J. Angus MacLean Natural Areas Award), which is given to an individual, group or agency who has made a significant contribution to protect the natural areas of PEI.



MacLEAN, Ronald William

WWII

Ronald was born in Alberton District, the son of Henry Willis and Violet Jean (Johnson) MacLean. He enlisted in the Army on February 8, 1945 and was discharged on October 6, 1945. He served as a Private in the #6 District Depot in Canada.

MacLEOD, George Garfield 

WWII

Sapper George Garfield MacLeod was killed in action in 1944. He was born on February 22, 1910 in Fairview to his parents Hector and Jane (Jessie) (MacFadyen) MacLeod. His siblings: Annie, John, Margaret and Pearl. He enlisted with the Royal Canadian Engineers during the Second World War. Antwerp, Belgium had been the site of battle during both the First and Second World Wars. The city was held during World War I from 1914 until Armistice in 1918. German Forces returned to Belgium in 1940. Germany occupied Antwerp until it was liberated by the Allied Forces on September 4, 1944. The town and port were secured in September, but it was weeks before the approaches from the North Sea could be cleared of German resistance. George MacLeod was serving with the 10th Field Park Coy of the Canadian Engineers when he was killed on November 23, 1944. He was 34 years old. He is buried in the Schoonselhof Cemetery in Wilrijk, a suburb of Antwerp, Belgium. The site is 57 kilometres from Brussels. George MacLeod is commemorated on Page 375 of the Second World War Book of Remembrance.



MacQUARRIE, Heath Ward 

WWI

Heath was born in Victoria-by-the-Sea, PEI on March 28, 1891, the son of William Archibald MacQuarrie and Charlotte Mallett. A fisherman before enlistment in 1917, Heath was married to Bertha May Francis and the father of their son Dick. He served with 105th Overseas Draft Battalion, 13th Reserve Battalion, and 23rd Reserve (NB) Battalion in Canada, the United Kingdom and France during World War I. After being sent to France in November 1917, Heath lost his life due to enemy fire on August 18, 1918. He is buried at Wood Cemetery in Marcelcave, France.



MARTIN, Joseph Arthur 

WWI

Arthur was born in Bloomfield, PEI. He served in the Canadian Army with the 105th Battalion in France during World War I.

MARTIN, L. Hurman 

WWII

Hurman was born in Glen Martin, PEI in 1915. He served with the Royal Canadian Air Force from 1939 to 1945. Herman is deceased.



MARTIN, Simon Edward

WWII

Simon was born in Bloomfield District, the son of Hector and Angeline (Peters) Martin. He enlisted in the Army on May 15, 1942 and was discharged on August 22, 1946. He served as a Corporal in the #6 District Depot in the United Kingdom and Continental Europe.



MATTHEW, John B. 

WWII

John was born in Souris, PEI in 1921. He served in the Royal Canadian Infantry Corp with the Glasgow Highlanders. He was killed in action at the age of 24 in Holten, Netherlands.

MATTHEWS, Brenton Emmerson

WWII

Brenton was born in Alberton District, the son of Emmerson and Maude (Fraser) Matthews. He enlisted in the Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve on April 25, 1943 and was discharged on November 7, 1945. He served as an Able Seaman.




MATTHEWS, Myrl Clifford

WWII

Myrl was born in Bloomfield District, the son of Silas and Lydia (Wells) Matthews. He enlisted in the Army on February 11, 1943 and was discharged on December 13, 1945. He served as a Private in the Prince of Wales Own Regiment in PEI and Canada.



McALDUFF, John James 

WWI

John was born in Alberton, PEI. He served in the Canadian Army with the New Brunswick Regiment, 44th Battalion. He was killed in action while serving in World War I.

McALDUFF, Justin Charles

WWII

Justin was born in Alberton District, son of Charles and Dorothy Sarah (Gillis) McAlduff. He enlisted in the Army on February 5, 1942 and was discharged on March 12, 1946. He served as a Private in the #6 District Depot C.A. in the United Kingdom, Holland and Germany.



McASKILL, Joseph Patrick "Joe" 

WWII

Joe was born in Tracadie, PEI in 1911, the son of Francis Dougal and Angelina Brazil McAskill. He enlisted on July 15, 1940, discharged on December 15, 1945. He was a private in the Prince Edward Island Highlanders and served in the North Atlantic Area, United Kingdom, Central Mediterranean Area and Continental Europe. For his service, he received the 1939-1945 Star, Italy Star, France and Germany Star, and the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and Clasp. He was a member of The Royal Canadian Legion Branch 1 for approximately 45 years. Joe passed away in 1995.



McCABE, Bernard St. Clair

PEACETIME

Born in Newton, PEI to John R. McCabe and Rose McGuigan in 1938. He began his Navy career at HMCS Queen Charlotte in 1956. He was posted to HMCS Patriot in Hamilton for shore training and communications courses learning to communicate with flags and Morse Code. He boarded the ship HMCS Wallesburg and underwent rigorous training in seamanship and survival.

In 1957, during his SDU years, he trained with the UNTD doing drills in the evening at Queen Charlotte with spring and summer training at HMCS Stadacona in Halifax, HMCS Cornwallis and Royal Roads Military College in Victoria, BC. He also trained aboard the HMCS Thunder, HMCS Wallesburg and HMCS New Waterford. Bernard graduated as Sub-Lieutenant in 1960 from Royal Roads. He was then posted as officer in charge of the movement of personnel at HMCS

Patriot. He continued his Navy career while attending Dalhousie Law School where he was posted to HMCS Stadacona in 1962. There he set and corrected examinations for sea going officers and was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant. In 1963, Bernard was appointed Term Lieutenant for a division of officer cadets at HMCS Cornwallis. Bernard was proud to serve and train with the Navy in the Atlantic, the Pacific and the Great Lakes.

Following graduation from Law School, Bernard was placed on the retired Naval officer list in 1964. He transferred to the Primary Reserve in 1975 attached to National Defence Headquarters for service with the Judge Advocate General Branch (JAG). He defended shipboard courts martial on appointment. Bernard retired from JAG in 1985.

Commander McCabe is a member of George R. Pearks Summerside Branch 5 of The Royal Canadian Legion. He joined in 1967 – a member for 54 years.



McCABE, John Raymond

WWII

John R. McCabe was very aware of current affairs and concepts of democracy and freedom. The son of Thomas McCabe and Margaret McBride he was born in 1898 and reared in Newton, PEI. While working in the fields between 1940-1941, he was often witness to the Harvard Trainers (airplanes) constantly flying overhead from the Base in Summerside, PEI.

In the summer of 1941, at age 43, John R. announced to his family that he had to join up. He joined The Royal Canadian Air Force and sold the farm in 1942. He served as a Service Policeman in the Air Force.

He trained in St. Jean, Quebec and served in Gander, Newfoundland which was considered overseas at the time. In Gander, he stood guard around airfields and often told stories about getting to know the young

airmen and waving them off on their missions and how sad it was when they never returned.

In 1944, he was transferred to the Summerside Base and then later discharged. Rev. Francis Bolger referred to John R. as an unselfish man who made a great impact on family and community. He stated that he was richer for having John R. as a cousin and a friend. He was a member of The Royal Canadian Legion Borden Carleton Branch 10 prior to his death in 1981.



McCOLL, Daniel Alexander

WWII

Daniel was born in Alberton District. He enlisted in the Army on September 11, 1940 and was discharged on August 22, 1945. He served as a Corporal in the Canadian Forestry Corps in Canada and the United Kingdom.

McCORMICK, Harold 

WWI & WWII

Harold was born in Ebbsfleet, PEI. He served with the Canadian Army in the Veterans Guard in Canada.



McDONALD, Donald 

WWI

Private Donald McDonald was born on November 3, 1897, in Rice Point to his parents, Mrs. Allan McDonald. He had five siblings: Neil, John, Mary, Grace, Lester. Donald volunteered while living in North Regina, Saskatchewan where he worked as a labourer. He volunteered in Regina on March 20, 1916. He was eighteen years old. Private McDonald was involved in the Battle of Ypres. At the age of nineteen, he suffered shrapnel wounds during the conflict. His head wounds were extreme, and he was not expected to survive. His injuries left him hemiplegic. Donald spent time in rehabilitation in Southern England and Halifax, Nova Scotia. He had to learn to walk and talk again. After rehabilitation, Private McDonald returned to Rice Point where he worked on the farm with his mother. He married Flora (Lola) Campbell. Donald had one child, Mary Ethelyn Euphemia.

WWI

Private Givin McDonald was born on September 21, 1895, in Nine Mile Creek to parents Malcolm and Letitia (McDougall) McDonald. His siblings were Margaret, Bertha, Hugh, Julia, Helen, Robert, Charlotte, Florence. Givin McDonald was already active in the 82nd Regiment Militia when he enlisted. He also worked as a butcher. Givin volunteered with the 105th Overseas Battalion on October 29, 1915, in Charlottetown. He was nineteen years old. After the war, Givin married twice. His first wife was Elsie Campbell. After her death, he then married Jessie Henley (1912-1976). 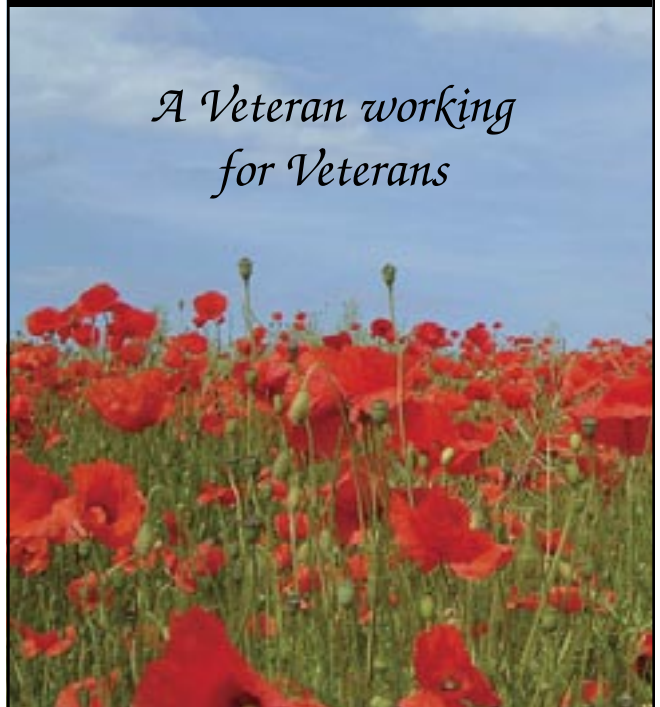

In 1962, he married Della Medina Trowsdale from Tyron, PEI. He worked as a cook in many locations such as Beachgrove Inn, with CN Ferries, at the County Jail and at St. Dunstan's University. Dewar passed away in 1992.

SHERREN, Elwin Cannon

KOREA

Elwin was born in 1931 in Crapaud, PEI, the son of Frederick and Emily (Cannon) Sherren. He enlisted in the Army and served from 1950 to 1954 and served as a Gunner. In 1950, he joined the 119th AA Battery, Heavy Artillery Regiment then transferred to the Royal Canadian Horse Artillery (RCHA). He saw action during the Korean War and was awarded the Korean War Medal, Canadian Volunteer Medal and United Nations Service Medal. Elwin is a 65-year member of The Royal Canadian Legion.



SHERREN, George Edward 

WWI

George was born in 1891 in Crapaud, PEI, the son of William Douglas and Florence Sherren. He enlisted in the Canadian Expeditionary Force in October 1915 and was assigned to the 2nd Canadian Siege Battery as a Gunner. He was sent overseas on SS Lapland in the fall of 1915. He served in France and parts of Belgium during World War I. He was wounded in one of the battles of Passchendaele. He mustered out from the Army in August 1919 and returned to PEI. George did not end his military association; he was awarded the Honorary Officer's Meritorious Badge of Service. He served as a recruitment officer for Prince Edward Island Company of Veteran's Guard and was commissioned as Captain in the 17th Reconnaissance Regiment Reserve Army. George passed away in 1979.

SHERREN, John Stephen 

WWI & WWII

John was born in 1895 in Crapaud, PEI, the son of William and Florence Sherren. He enlisted from King's College where he was a Theological student and went overseas with the Nova Scotia Highlanders in 1915. He then transferred to the Royal Air Force in England and on receiving his wings was commissioned as Flight Lieutenant. On one of these missions, he made a crash landing, was wounded, and hospitalized until the end of the war. At the outbreak of World War II, he enlisted as Chaplain in the Royal Canadian Navy. He served overseas and was in London when the Battle of Britain was at its peak. He retired at the end of hostilities with the rank of Lieutenant Commander. It is interesting to note that John served in all three branches of the Armed Forces. John passed away in 1976.

SHERREN, Percy Clark 

WWI

Clark was born in 1893 in Crapaud, PEI, the son of William and Florence Sherren. He enlisted in June 1915 as a Lieutenant in the Canadian Expeditionary Force to serve during World War I. He transferred to the Royal Air Force as a member of 27 Squadron and served with that unit until the war ended. Clark earned a reputation for daring and bravery. The "Moncton Transcript" reported "not long ago he brought down five machines in one day, single handed, while the whole British Army watched in wonderment and surprise at his magnificent feats of daring." He was awarded the Military Cross in 1916 for descending to altitude of within five hundred feet to drop two 112-pound bombs on the Gouzeaucourt Railway Station, claiming destruction of an engine and an enemy ammunition train. He was awarded the Bar to his MC in 1917. He was granted a permanent Commission in the Royal Air Force in 1919 and then resigned from the Canadian Expeditionary Force. At the same time, he was gazetted as a Major in the Reserve of Officers of the Canadian Militia. Clark passed away in 1937.



SHERREN, Reginald Gray

KOREA

Reginald was born in Crapaud, PEI, the son of Arthur and Rita Sherren. He enlisted in the Army and served from 1950 to 1953 and 1955 to 1958. He served in the Regiment Signal Corps as a Radio Operator and served in the Korean War from 1952 to 1953. He was awarded the Korean War Medal, the Canadian Parachute Badge, the Canadian Volunteer Service Medal and the United Nations Service Medal.

He served in England that same year and landed in France shortly after D-Day. He was promoted to the rank of Captain and was mentioned in numerous dispatches. On March 15, 1945, he was awarded the M.B.E. with this citation: "For a most valuable contribution in designing special equipment for use by Survey Regiments in the field." Captain Sherren's name is famous in all Survey Regiments as he produced many technological improvements. Even in Italy a great number of enemy guns were located by means of the "Sherren Plotter". On April 25, 1945, while on a reconnaissance mission in Germany, he was mortally wounded and died three days later, on April 28. He is buried in the Canadian Military War Graves Cemetery near Groesbeek, Holland.

SHREENAN, Leo A. 

WWII

Leo was born on October 26, 1910, in Kinkora, PEI. He served in the Royal Canadian Air Force in Canada from November 18, 1942, to April 29, 1946. He was a member of The Royal Canadian Legion Borden-Carleton Branch 10. Leo passed away in 2000 and is buried in Kinkora.



SMITH, Colin James

WWII

Colin was born in Bloomfield District, the son of John and Lila Mae (Costain) Smith. He enlisted in the Army on February 13, 1942 and was discharged on November 2, 1945. He served as a Sapper in the Royal Canadian Engineers in Canada, Britain, Central Mediterranean and Northwest Europe.

William was born in Bloomfield District, the son of Hugh and Caroline (Matthews) Williams. He enlisted in the Royal Canadian Air Force on January 6, 1941 and was discharged on July 6, 1945. He served as a Leading Aircraftsman in Canada.

WOOD, John Lyman "Ly" 

WWI

John was born in North Tryon, PEI in 1897. He was a second-year engineering student at Acadia University before enlisting during World War I. John arrived in France from England on December 22, 1916, as part of the Second Infantry Battalion, which was part of the 1st Canadian Infantry Brigade during the Battle of Vimy Ridge. He survived Vimy Ridge, but lost his life on May 3, 1917, during the Battle of Arras, in the third battle of the Scarpe near Fresnoy. A signaller, he was killed while repairing telephone communications during the pre-dawn attack. His body was never recovered, and his name is engraved on the Vimy Memorial in France.



WORTH, Harvey Hammond

Harvey was born in 1939 in Charlottetown and grew up in Albany. He served two years in the Royal Canadian Navy from 1954 to 1956. Harvey did his basic training at HMCS Cornwallis and served on HMCS Quebec. He operated Mt Wheating in Ottawa for fifteen years before returning to PEI in 1980. He volunteered at Silver Fox Curling and Yacht Club. Harvey was married to Norma Larocque for 46 years and the father of two daughters.
