- Have at least one member of Poppy Committee on duty in the branch during Poppy Week.
- Plan where the canvassers will be placed for collections and Poppy distribution.
- Set up accounting office and number money boxes.
- Deliver boxes to business establishments.
- After campaign, pick up boxes at business establishments.
- ✓ Publish results through local media.
- Thank people for their support.
- Submit Poppy Trust Fund Branch Status Report.


Poppy Bracelet – "Lest We Forget"
