IN THE PROVINCE OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND**

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA- A Veteran's license plate is available to PEI resident who has been Honorably Discharged or is Still serving under the following requirements:

Please circle applicable letter

- A) has served in either the Canadian Forces, Canadian Reserve Forces, Allied Forces or Commonwealth Forces during WWII, the Korean War, gulf War or NATO/UN Missions
- B) Has served in either the Canadian or Allied Merchant Navy or the Ferry Command during war time
- C) Is currently serving or is an honorably released member of the Canadian Regular Forces paid service or has been medically released under Section 3A or 3B.
- D) Is currently serving or served in the Canadian Reserve Forces with a minimum of 1,085 days paid service.
- E) Is currently serving or is an honorably released member of the RCMP
- F) Is a member of a Canadian Police Force who served in a Special Duty Area or on a Special Duty Operation (NATO/UN).

VETERANS INFORMATION: The Veterans name must be on the vehicle registration. Vehicle(s) may be registered jointly with partner.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED. It is the responsibility of the Veteran to ensure that a copy of their service documentation is included. These documents must be in English. *CF One cards are not accepted.*

MILITARY RETIRED PERSONNEL: CF Certificate of Service or ND1175 card (both sides) or Allied Forces Certificate of Service or Canadian or Allied Merchant Navy Service Record Book. Proof of Medical release under Section 3A or 3B.

MILITARY STILL SERVING PERSONNEL: Both sides of the CF ID card and a current Military Personal Record Resume (MPRR)

RCMP Retired Member: Record of Service ID Card

RCMP STILL SERVING MEMBER: Service ID Card

CANADIAN POLICE FORCE: A letter from a Senior Officer or other proof of service for any NATO or UN operations, including dates:
