

Reactivation of ALC Video Lottery Terminals

June 12, 2020

The PEI Government announced in the newspaper this morning that the VLT's will be allowed to be opened in Phase 4 beginning on June 26th. I contacted our ALC Regional manager on your behalf to determine what prerequisites will have to be met and scheduled time frames for reactivation.

The VLT's located in our Legion Branches will **NOT** open all at the same time, ALC has a well-defined plan to reactivate our Legion VLT's.

When will ALC reactivate your VLT's?

1. Charlottetown and Summerside will be reactivated first on June 26th.
2. All rural areas will be reactivated *possibly* by the following Wednesday, July 1st.
3. ALC will contact each Branch to schedule a date and time for the reactivation.

Critical information:

Each Branch must have their COVID-19 plan in place before ALC technicians will reactivate the VLT's. The plan must include a plan to activate and sanitize each terminal. VERY IMPORTANT: Don't move any terminals!

1. As always social distancing is a must.
2. Plexi-glass barriers between VLT machines are **NOT** required.
3. VLT's are NOT to be moved! ALC is currently soliciting the PEI government to allow them to move terminals outside of the current gaming footprint at each Branch.
4. Each terminal and chair *MUST* be cleaned after each use.
5. Only one player is allowed at a machine at a time. No observers are allowed.

ALC will look after the following:

1. Provide training, signage, and cleaning solution for each Branch.
2. They will reactivate and/or move each terminal as required.
