

Francois was born in Alberton, PEI. He served the Army from August 5, 1918 until being discharged as Private on January 18, 1919.






ALLAN, Lee C.



ARSENAULT, Cyrus J.



BIRCH, William Thomas





Francis was born on March 8, 1915 in Long River, PEI. He enlisted with the Prince Edward Island Highlanders on July 15, 1940 and served in Canada, North Atlantic arena, United Kingdom, and Central Mediterranean arena until his discharge on April 15, 1946. Francis passed away on February 16, 1966.

FOLEY, John Joseph

WWII

John was born on February 19, 1912 in St. Theresa, PEI. He served with the 8th Battery, Royal Canadian Army from 1939-1945 in Heavy Artillery and Anti Aircraft in Europe. John has been a member of The Royal Canadian Legion for sixty years. He attends Remembrance Day activities and regular meetings.

Alcide enlisted in the Canadian Army in May 1942. He served with the Perth Regiment in England and Italy. He was taken prisoner at the battle of Arielli on January 16, 1943 just before the battle of Ortona. He was held prisoner for sixteen months in Germany.
